### TO THE OLD CEMETERY

**DISTANCE FROM TRAILHEAD:**  
5km (return)  
**TIME:** 2hrs  
**DIFFICULTY:** Grade 3\*


\*Generally a modified or hardened surface with some rough, beach and steep sections. Bushwalking experience recommended.



### TO BAUDIN CONSERVATION PARK

**DISTANCE FROM TRAILHEAD:**  
3.5km (return)  
**TIME:** 1.5hrs  
**DIFFICULTY:** Grade 3\*

\*Generally a modified or hardened surface with some rough, beach and steep sections. Bushwalking experience recommended. Note: A section of this walk is along the beach which may not be accessible at high tide.



## WARNING

- Beware of vehicles.
- Some parts of the walk have uneven, rough and slippery surfaces.
- Snakes have been seen within the area.
- Exercise caution at water crossings and on the beach.
- Leave no trace: take your rubbish with you or use the bins provided.

Your safety is your responsibility. Caution is required. In the case of an emergency dial 000.
